We proudly present our proposals for the development of an 87-bed care home at 160-164 Hurlingham Road, SW6 3NG.

## The proposals

The development of a care home at 160-164 Hurlingham Road SW6 3NG, will revitalise a brownfield site that has been mostly vacant for several years. Given the accessibility of the site, development of it could visually improve the area, deliver a much needed care home and significant local benefits.

The proposals for Hurlingham Road respond to the great need for a care home locally and will deliver specialist residential, nursing and dementia care with a market leading operator. The care home will be fit for the future with a modern design that also respects the character of the surrounding area.

The scheme will provide accommodation for 87 residents, across its four/five storeys, split into household communities that will have:

- » Eight care bedrooms with en-suite bathrooms
- » Resident household day lounge
- » Winter garden/balcony
- » Resident household dining and domestic kitchen
- » Assisted bathing facilities and assisted WCs

there will be active communal areas, including:

- » Garden lounge
- » Secure sensory garden
- » Sensory room
- » Cinema room
- » Multifunction activity area
- » Hairdresser
- » Treatment/consultation room

This type of specialist building caters for elderly people who are at the end of their life with very high, 24-hour, end-of-life care needs, have complex nursing needs, or are living with advanced Stage 6/7 dementia.
